The Manusa project was born out of a love for Romani music. Julia Kozakova aims to make the beauty of these traditional sounds accessible to a wider audience. She is accompanied by a cimbalom band of renowned Romani musicians. With great sensitivity and empathy, the album weaves tradition and improvisation.

Choosing a repertoire representative of all eras of tango, including French and foreign musicians in its line-up, staunchly defending gender parity within its team and inviting artists from other creative fields (dance, visual arts, singing, theatre), the members of the septet perform in a diverse and cross-disciplinary manner, thus positioning themselves far from divisive and conservative mechanisms. <u>Listen.</u>



Nancy Vieira & Fred Martins: Esperanca

Cape Verdean singer Nancy Vieira and Rio de Janeiro-born singer-songwriter Fred Martins met in 2013. Since then, the two have collaborated on numerous concerts and recordings, ultimately venturing into a joint album. The album masterfully combines the incomparable beauty of Brazilian and Cape Verdean music , while also conveying the emotions that the duo wishes to express in the current climate. <u>Listen.</u>



Hartwin: This Is The Place

Hartwin is a diatonic accordionist and composer whose instrumental music has touched audiences around the world for many years. Together with Flavia Escartin on cello and Pavel Souvandjiev on violin, the trio creates a kind of musical tightrope act-balancing classical, folk, and world music in a performance where they constantly challenge and enrich one another.



Either/Orchestra&Ethiopian Guests: Ethiopiques32-Nalbandian l'Ethiopien

This is Ethiopia in the mid-1950s and early 1960s, on the eve of the blossoming, or rather the explosion, of Swinging Addis. Rock'n'roll, rhythm and blues, soul and twist had not yet burst onto the scene, and the atmosphere was still steeped in the post-war big band era, with Glenn Miller's In the Mood enduring as a global anthem on a par with the Latin wave which was also popular at the time.



Muluken Mellesse: Muluken Mellesse

This re-release of one of the last vinyl records released in Ethiopia, but more than that it is the absolute masterpiece of Ethiopian Groove - and its swansong. It leaves posterity with a clear idea of the level of sophistication and mastery that modern Ethiopian music had reached before it was crushed under the military-Stalinist boot of the Derg - the word that stands for the bloody revolution that had been underway since 1974.



Elias Bachoura: Biharayto (street date: December 12th, 2025)

Through eight personal compositions, Bachoura paints a world in which Eastern and Western influences merge, in which modal, tonal and atonal styles evoke countless images of revolutions, the world of the foreigner. His pieces range from deep makams to elaborate compositions. Elias developed his own style, Syrian tradition of Damascus complemented by his Western classical training.



WÖR x Kongero: Songbooks Live (street date: January 23rd, 2026)

Wor and Kongero have joined forces for an extraordinary project with Songbooks Live: exploring commonalities and contrasts between their different musical traditions and repertoires. Both bands delved into historical archives with one goal: to find songs suitable for a Belgian-Swedish collaboration and letting timeless emotions and exquisite tunes speak through their own arrangements. <u>Listen.</u>



Gao Hong: Symphony of Self (street date January 23rd, 2026)

With Symphony of Self, Gao Hongs artistry soars to new heights as she composes, orchestrates and performs the pipa in four concertos-masterfully weaving ancient Pudong pipa traditions into the richness of a full Western orchestra. Recorded at the legendary Abbey Road Studios with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, her four pipa concertos forge a striking cultural fusion, giving the Chinese lute a bold new voice in classical music.



Spelim: In Art We Trust

An eclectic and sunny musical journey, In Art We Trust is the debut album from SPELIM, a multi-talented artist and charismatic showman. Through 12 vibrant tracks of dread pop, he fuses groove, reggae, electro and soul in a declaration of love for art and sharing. Nourished by multiple encounters and inspirations, this global project is revealing a passionate creator who celebrates life and creativity with energy and sincerity. Listen.

Extensa: Echomora

"Echomora" is the second album from the Extensa trio, which combines instrumental noise, post-metal, and a trance-like sound inspired by krautrock traditions. A redefinition of music that was created before their debut record, but at that time and in that configuration, it wasn't meant to materialize. Time acted naturally, like evolution - making the music more intense, heavier and more massive, without losing its original energy. Listen.

Javier Girotto & Fabrizio Bosso: Desde Cuando

Desde Cuando, the third album by the Latin Mood ensemble following Sol and Vamos, tells the story of a musical partnership and journey spanning two decades. In the fertile ground of jazz and improvisation, seemingly distant aesthetics come together: the hard bop for which Bosso is a leading figure and the Latin influences and rhythms that characterize Girottos style. <u>Listen.</u>



Maria Pia De Vito: Buarquena

The new album by Maria Pia De Vito is called "Buarqueana", featuring the extraordinary participation of Chico Buarque and Mônica Salmaso. Recorded in Rio de Janeiro, this project is dedicated to the Neapolitan translation and musical reinterpretation of the work of Chico Buarque de Hollanda. A poetic and literary album, the result of a four-handed collaboration in researching the repertoire and refining the translations. Listen.



Simona Severini & Jacopo Ferrazza: Dream Scenario

Dream Scenario, the first album by the new duo formed by singer-songwriter and guitarist Simona Severini and double bassist Jacopo Ferrazza. Simona and Jacopo evoke a suspended state, a fascinating and disturbing limbo, translated into music through different languages. <u>Listen.</u>

Together, the musicians set out for new horizons: where the familiar and the unfamiliar meet. Listen.

Robin Nicaise & Alain Soler: Letter To Bill

This album celebrates a true and long-standing bond between the two musicians, who have known each other for over thirty years. Listen.



The New Gypsies: Featuring Vic Juris (street date: January 9th, 2026)

A long-awaited release that features the late guitar master at his most lyrical and inventive was recorded in January 2017 but held back until now. This session led by vibraphonist Tony Miceli is a poignant tribute to Vic Juriss boundless musicality and deep connection to the jazz tradition. Inspired by the spirit of Django Reinhardt and the Hot Club legacy, the quartet reimagines classic French repertoire with fresh arrangement.



Matt Garrity: Suits And Scotches (street date: January 9th, 2026)

The debut album of drummer Matt Garrity, a long-standing figure in the New York jazz scene whose artistry has matured over three decades of collaboration with legends such as Joe Lovano, Vincent Herring, and Joel Forrester. Suits And Scotches captures the essence of Garritys musical journey, featuring original compositions and fresh interpretations of jazz standards performed by his seasoned quartet.



Dave Pietro: The Butterfly Effect (street date January 16th, 2026)

Following the critical acclaim of The Talisman (SCCD 31955), alto saxophonist Dave Pietro returns with The Butterfly Effect. A veteran of ensembles led by Maria Schneider, Toshiko Akiyoshi, and Gil Evans, Pietro continues to command attention as a composer and bandleader whose work is both intellectually rigorous and emotionally resonant.



John McNeil & Tom Harrel: Look To The Sky (street date: January 23rd, 2026) G 1128 / 0716043112814 / label: SteepleChase Records / format: LP / USA – Jazz

Originally released in 1979 and reissued on CD in 1996 with bonus material, this album stands as a vibrant snapshot of two masterful trumpeters-John McNeil and Tom Harrell-at a pivotal moment in modern jazz. Now, for the first time, this landmark session returns in stunning 24bit/96kHz remastered fidelity on heavyweight 180g vinyl, preserving the warmth and swing of the original analog tapes.
